is quick and easy. No more than a 10 minute wait!

This special chemical waste collection service is only for residents
of the Connecticut River Estuary Region towns.

Acceptable Materials

Household:

- Drain cleaners
- Metal polish
- Oven cleaners
- Floor cleaners
- Mothballs
- Photo chemicals
- Full/partially-full aerosols
- Arts & crafts supplies
- Household batteries
- Asbestos-containing material (double-bag in plastic bags & wet down)
- Water-reactive materials (such as peroxides and metallic sodium)
- Mercury Thermometers (A free digital thermometer will be given in exchange.)

Garage:

- Fire starters including hand-held propane torch cylinders
- Old chemistry kits
- Transmission fluid
- Gasoline, kerosene
- Waxes and polishes
- Brake fluid
- Rust preventatives

Workshop:

- Rust preventatives
- Wood preservatives
- Wood strippers
- Oil-based paint
- Lead-based paint
- Paint thinner
- Degreasers
- Solvents
- Sealants

Yard/Garden:

- Weed killer
- Insect sprays
- Rodent poison
- Muriatic acid/pool chemicals
- Cesspool cleaners

Unacceptable Materials

- Latex paint (This can be air-dried or dried with sawdust or kitty litter and disposed in the garbage.)
- Explosives, fireworks, ammunition

- (Contact the State Police.)
- BBQ Propane tanks
- (Contact propane gas company)
- Fire extinguishers (Contact your fire department.)
- Empty aerosol cans
- Radioactive material
- Drugs
- Infectious or biologically active materials
- Waste Oil
- Vehicle Batteries
- Unknown materials
- Any commercial hazardous waste
- (Contact CRERPA for information.)

Identification required; Drivers' licenses will be checked.

There is no fee to attend.

Commercial waste is not accepted at HHW Collections.

Directions to the Estuary Region HHW Facility

From Rte. 9 driving north:

Take Exit 4, Go straight off exit ramp

Cross over RR tracks,

Pass CRRA Transfer Station

HHW facility is on the left.

From Rte. 9 driving south:

Take Exit 4, Go left off exit ramp

At light, go right

Cross over RR tracks

Pass CRRA Transfer Station

HHW facility is on the left.
